Contract of Carriage by Sea under the Saudi Commercial Maritime Law for the year 1440AH

Trade is mainly based on the exchange of goods and products between individuals, whether they are in one country or different countries; that is why transportation is deemed to be the most important at the present time. However, transportation varies according to the means and field thereof, and it can be by air via aircraft, or by land via vehicles or by sea via ships. However, in the field of foreign trade, sea transport of goods is the dominant type of transport, because it represents 75% of international trade. Moreover, sea transport of goods, in general, is the most important form of trade in products. Sea transport in the Kingdom represents a major factor of trade; accordingly, the Saudi Commercial Maritime Law, for the year 1440AH, gives a paramount significance to the contract of carriage by sea due to its important role in the international trade.
