



General Agreement of Trade in Service Provisions and Effects

This book deals with the liberalization of international trade from historical and economical aspects, by way of elaborating on the organizations which are concerned with international economic liberalization in general. This book also deals with the negotiations connected with the general agreement on tariff and trade up to the present time, as well as the general rules governing the World Trade Organization (WTO) and its method of management, and other related issues. Additionally, the book elaborates on the General Agreement on Trade in Services and the detailed rules governing the application of this agreement to the member states. The book comprises an introductory chapter with the title, "General Opinion about the Liberalization of Trade," and another chapter about the General Agreement on Trade in Services (including the general provisions of GAT, and a detailed study on financial and banking services); and Chapter Three deals with the effects of applying the General Agreement on Trade in Services on the balance of payments in Egypt, and the expected effects on applying the General Agreement on Trade in Services.
